



ELIGIBILITY

Nepali or non-Nepali national with a 10+2 or intermediate or equivalent level study program of at least two-year duration in any discipline with minimum of **40% in aggregate or CGPA of 1.6 on the scale of 4.0 and minimum 'D+' grade in each subject** from a university/board recognized by Kathmandu University. GCE Advanced Level student should have passed minimum three subjects in A Level and one general paper in AS Level with marks/grades requirements as mentioned above. International Baccalaureate (IB) students should have passed minimum 6 courses (at least 3 courses in Higher Level) with 24 points in aggregate. CTEVT student should have three-year diploma with 40% in aggregate. CBSE student should have minimum 40% in aggregate.
